



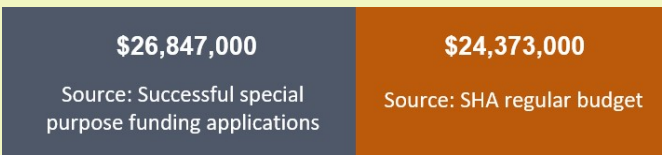

SHA's Homelessness Impact

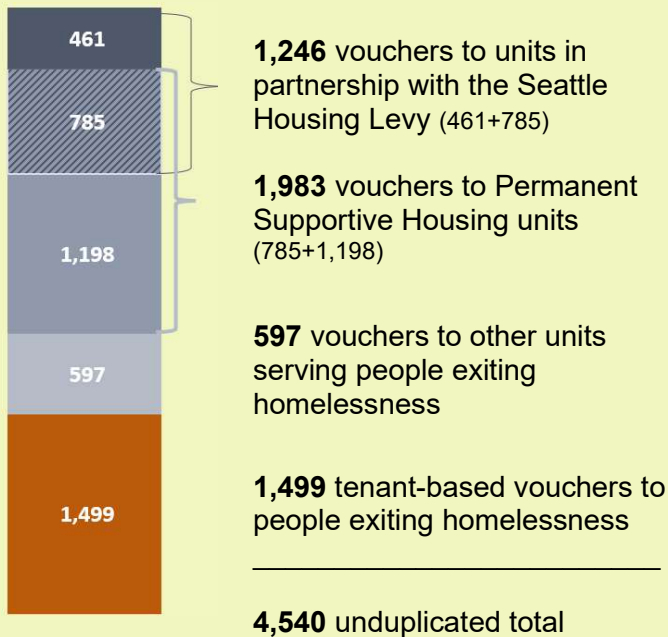
Committed Resources*

\$50 million dedicated annually to housing formerly homeless

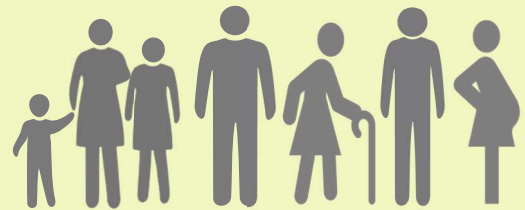
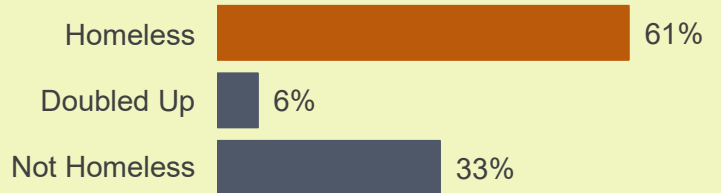


3,041 units + 1,499 tenant-based subsidies dedicated to housing formerly homeless

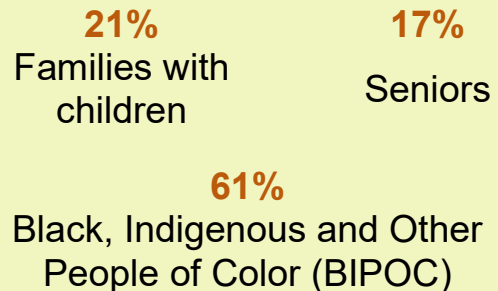


People Served*
