PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Contractor will be required to provide, either through self performance or the management of Subcontractors, the following elements of work, including but not limited to the complete renovation of the interior/exterior (excluding the roof) of a single family home on Spruce Street.

ESTIMATE: The estimate for this project is between \$240,000 and \$250,000.

BID SUBMITTAL: Sealed bids must be received for this project by the Seattle Housing Authority (SHA) at its offices at 190 Queen Anne Avenue North (5th Floor, Reception), Seattle, Washington 98109, no later than **1:00 PM on December 1, 2017**. Bids received after 1:00 PM will not be accepted or read. Faxed bids will not be accepted
