Bidders/Proposers shall take this Addendum into consideration when preparing and submitting their response to this solicitation.

This Addendum lists questions received and SHA's responses (see Item 1 below) and extends the due date of this solicitation (see Item 2 below).

Item 1. The following is a list of questions received and SHA's responses to those questions.

Question 1.: Is there a detailed price form for us to submit, or will we just need to utilize page 2 of 2 with the brief bid breakdown?

Response: There is no detailed price form. Please indicate pricing in applicable sections on page 2 of the Request For Bid (#5884).

Question 2.: In regards to permitting, is it correct that we will only be preparing and submitting the traffic control plan that will be submitted in tandem with the permit SHA obtains? Or are there further permitting needs that we will need to fulfill?

Response: Due to the size and number of trees to be removed which are in public right-of-way, SHA anticipates Contractor will need to prepare and apply for Construction Use Permit for working in the street right-of-way. Bid to include cost for permit and preparation of affiliated Contractor Traffic Control Plans.

Question 3.: For the tree sections to be salvaged for carpentry work, will there be a breakdown or a specific contact for us to discuss that with? Will we need to leave the sections onsite, or transport them to another location?

Response: SHA has determined that salvage of diseased elm wood is cost prohibitive and all wood to be disposed of appropriately.
