PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Seattle Housing Authority, is soliciting bids from experienced General Contractors, who will be required to provide, either through self-performance or the management of Subcontractors, the restoration of an apartment unit 201 damaged by a fire including restoration of hallways, adjacent stairwells, the south-west exterior corner of the building as well as other residential units below, above and adjacent. Unit 201 requires major architectural, structural, electrical and interior renovation and remodeling of fire damaged building components and electrical services (i.e.; severely damaged by exposure to heat and flames). All Work will occur in an occupied building.

Bids received after 1:00 PM will not be accepted or read.
