Right Sizing

35 gallon containers are the most popular size, but we recommend choosing based on the size of your household.

Our average customer produces about 13 gallons of garbage per person each week. But many generate less! Here's how you can choose the container size that's right for your home.

No. of	Container
People	Size
1-2	12 Gallon
2-3	20 Gallon
3-4	35 Gallon
4-5	65 Gallon
6+	95 Gallon

Bulky Item	\$30.00 (per item)	Must schedule prior to garbage pickup collection day.
E-Waste	\$20.00	Must schedule prior to garbage collection day and fit in a 2'x2'x2' Box
Christmas Trees	Free through January	After January 31 st , charged as extra yard waste.
Used Oil	Free on recycle day	Place sealed, labeled plastic jug next to recycle container on recycle pickup day.
Sharps	We do not collect	Take to healthcare provider, designated box, or SPU transfer station.
CFL Bulbs / Batteries	\$5.00	Must schedule prior to garbage collection. Limit Two 1-gallon bags per single family.
